Info re LD service users

service users known to Lancashire Care NHS Trust with a learning disability who pay rent for their accommodation.

Can you tell me;

How many service users pay rents to landlords?

How much rent do they pay individually per week?

For each individual, who is their landlord, what is the landlord status, (e.g. social housing, charitable status, housing association, etc.)?

What is the total rent paid where there are more than one service user sharing accommodation and what is the accommodation type, (e.g. two bed terrace, three bed semi-detached, purpose built, etc.)?

For each service user who provides their residential support services? i.e., company name and address, and status, (e.g. is the provider statutory, charity, independent, etc.)?

For each service user how much housing benefit per week do they receive?

How many service users were previously provided residential support services by the NHS in 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015?

And how much rent did each individual pay in rent weekly at that time from 2005 - 2015?

Response Detail:

The Trust does not hold this information in a searchable format and only by accessing each service user's personal file manually could the information be obtained.

I understand that Lancashire County Council and Blackburn with Darwen unitary Authority hold registers and contact details of each of the Social Care Landlords / Housing Providers that operate within their areas and provide accommodation for people with a Learning Disability. The charges that are made will be dependent on the policy of the Provider and individual clients personal financial circumstances.
